MORE ABUNDANT HONOR

- 1Co 8:2 And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know.
- Isa 55:8 For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD.
- Isa 55:9 For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- 1Co 14:37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I [the apostle Paul] write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.
- Mat 5:8 Blessed *are* the **pure** in heart: for they shall see God.
- Tit 1:15 Unto the **pure** all things *are* **pure**: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving *is* nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.
- 1Co 12:23 And those members of the body [the human body temple], which we think [The Greek word means "Which we have been taught to think"] to be less honourable, upon these [as a commandment of the Lord, see 1Cor 14:37] we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.
- 1Co 12:24 For our comely *parts* have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having **given more abundant honour to that** *part* **which lacked**:
- Hos 4:6 My people are destroyed for <u>lack</u> of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Eph 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, <u>that ye may be able to withstand</u> <u>in the evil day</u> [especially today], and having done all, to stand.

- Eph 6:14 Stand therefore, **having your loins girt about with truth**, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;
- Exo 1:5 And all the souls that **<u>came out of the loins of Jacob</u>** were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt *already*.
- Exo 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; *with* your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it *is* the LORD'S passover.
- Joh 13:4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and <u>girded</u> <u>himself</u>.
- Joh 13:5 After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel wherewith he was **girded**.

The many truths taught by one's actual loins should always be taught as an inseparable part of the truth of the Passover and the reception of the seal of God. The word, "loins," is used no less than 61 times in Scripture. Of these 61 times the word, "loins" is always used to refer to the generational sacred parts in the loins with only one exception. On only one occasion is it used to figuratively refer to "the loins of your mind" in 1 Peter 1:13. And in this single reference the intent is for the reader to intelligently understand the truths which are taught by the actual physical loins which are "girt about with truth." However, because of Roman Catholic Augustinian theology, Puritanical theology and Victorian theology, the direct commandment of YHWH has been totally reversed to say that the loins only applies to the mind!

- **Rev 11:1** And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and <u>measure the temple of God</u>, and the altar, and them that worship therein.
- Eze 43:10 Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their iniquities: and let them measure the pattern. (Superior translations say "show <u>the</u> <u>meaning of the temple</u> to the house of Israel.)
- Eze 43:11 And if they be ashamed of all that they have done, shew them the form of the house, and the fashion thereof, and the goings out thereof, and the comings in thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the laws thereof: and write *it* in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and do them.
- Eze 43:12 This is the law of the house; Upon the top of the mountain the whole limit thereof round about shall be most holy. Behold, this is the law of the house.
- Eze 43:13 <u>And these *are* the measures of the altar after the cubits</u>: The cubit *is* a cubit and an hand breadth; even the bottom *shall be* a cubit, and the breadth a cubit, and the border thereof by the edge thereof round about *shall be* a span: and this *shall be* the higher place of the altar.
- 1Ki 6:2 And the house which king Solomon built for the LORD, the length thereof *was* threescore cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty *cubits*, and the height thereof thirty cubits.
- 1Ki 6:3 And the porch before the temple of the house, twenty cubits *was* the length thereof, according to the breadth of the house; *and* ten cubits *was* the breadth thereof before the house.
- 1Ki 6:4 And for the house he made windows of narrow lights.
- 1Ki 6:5 And against the wall of the house he built chambers round about, *against* the walls of the house round about, *both* of the temple and of the oracle: and he made chambers round about:
- 1Ki 6:6 The nethermost chamber *was* five cubits broad, and the middle *was* six cubits broad, and the third *was* seven cubits broad: for without *in the wall* of the house he made narrowed rests round about, that *the beams* should not be fastened in the walls of the house.
- 1Ki 6:7 And the house, when it was in building, <u>was built of stone made ready before it was</u> <u>brought thither</u> [this is referring to the genetic seed perfectly formed in the Father's body before conception takes place]: so <u>that there was neither hammer nor axe nor any tool of</u>

iron heard in the house, while it was in building. [the building blocks of the DNA/RNA cause the unborn child to develop in silence in the most Holy Place of the mother's womb.]

- 1Ki 6:8 <u>The door for the middle chamber was in the right side of the house</u> [the entrance to the right fallopian tube]: and they went up with winding stairs [how the winding right fallopian tube goes to the right ovary and then back] into the middle chamber [which is the most holy place of the womb], and out of the middle [the womb] into the third [chamber which is the left ovary via the implied left winding staircase].
- 1Ki 6:9 So he built the house, and finished it; and covered the house with beams and boards of cedar.

1 Kings 6:2-9 is the most amazing proof that the "loins" of the human body temple are indeed the antitypical "Most Holy Place." The same is also true of the parts of human head and etc.

Joh 2:19 Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

- Joh 2:20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days?
- Joh 2:21 But he spake of **the temple of his body**.

Rev 21:22 And I saw no temple therein: for <u>the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the</u> <u>temple of it</u>.

Few Christians realize that one of the major reasons why our heavenly Father had the typical temple in Jerusalem destroyed was so the New Testament Church would make the transition in their thinking from the typical temple in Jerusalem made with hands to the antitypical human body temple and the antitypical temple of God in heaven, both made without hands.

1Co 6:14 And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power.

- 1Co 6:15 Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make *them* the members of an harlot? God forbid.
- 1Co 6:16 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.
- 1Co 6:17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.
- 1Co 6:18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication <u>sinneth against his own body</u>.
- 1Co 6:19 <u>What</u>? <u>know ye not that your body is the temple</u> of the Holy Ghost Spirit *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 1Co 6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore **glorify God in your body, and in your spirit**, which are God's.
- 1Co 3:16 Know ye not that <u>ye are the temple of God</u>, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
- 1Co 3:17 If any man defile <u>the temple of God</u>, <u>him shall God destroy</u>; for <u>the temple of God</u> <u>is holy</u>, <u>which temple ye are</u>. [This truth in the loins should help believers to remain pure.]
